The organization is working with its local partner, Interfaith League Against Poverty-Pakistan (I-LAP-PAK) to equip Christian youth with practical and sustainable skills. I-LAP-US/Pakistan has designed courses that enhance employability while also strengthening faith, confidence, and self-reliance. These programs respond to the unique struggles of the marginalized Christian communities, offering new opportunities for growth and dignity. Each course not only develops practical abilities but also nurtures biblical values of stewardship, service, and perseverance. In this way, I-LAP-US remains faithful to its mission of equipping young people with tools that restore their dignity, unlock their God-given potential, and prepare them to be shining witnesses of Christ in their communities.

1. Digital Skills: Graphic Design

Graduates of the Graphic Design course gain marketable digital skills for church media, NGOs, businesses, and global clients. With strong demand on freelancing platforms, many can earn \$700+ monthly, strengthening their family's livelihood.

2. Videography, Photography and Video & Photo Editing

Graduates gain practical storytelling skills to capture and edit professional visuals for weddings, events, churches, NGOs, and businesses. These high-demand abilities enable freelancing with potential monthly earnings of \$700 or more.

3. Search Engine Optimization (SEO) and Web Development

Graduates learn to improve search rankings and build functional websites, enabling work as SEO specialists, developers, or freelancers. With strong global demand, they can earn \$500–\$1,200 monthly while achieving financial independence.

4. Animation (2D & 3D)

Graduates master producing educational, ministry, promotional, and entertainment content. With a professional showreel, they can freelance for local and international clients, earning \$600–\$1,000 monthly in the growing animation market.

5. English Language and Communication

As a crosscutting course, English equips students to communicate confidently in business, media, and ministry contexts. Strong language skills expand client reach, attract global opportunities, and support sustainable freelance and professional careers.

The Institute of Emerging Leaders (TiEL) School System was established with the vision of nurturing visionary leaders from within the Christian community who can lead with dignity, confidence, and strategic foresight. TiEL seeks to empower students through quality academic education, professional training, and personality development, enabling them to attain respectable positions in the mainstream of national life. As the first institution of its kind, TiEL plays a critical role in



strengthening educational standards while intentionally cultivating leadership qualities to address the social, economic, and civic challenges faced by Christians in Pakistan. The program offers structured career counseling, guiding students toward white-collar professions through exposure to opportunities in the public and private sectors. It fosters political and civic awareness by addressing good governance, rule of law, minority rights, and interfaith harmony, preparing confident, responsible, and principled Christian leaders.

Vision: To regain the lost dignity of the Christian Community through professional education for obtaining their due share in all high-ranking positions in the Government and Private sectors.

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ADVOCATING FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH IN PAKISTAN



I-LAP-US, in partnership with the Pakistan Interfaith League (PIL) and I-LAP-Pakistan, actively advocates for the protection and rights of religious minorities in Pakistan. Together, these organizations consistently call for the fair and impartial implementation of Pakistan's laws to ensure justice for marginalized and persecuted communities and to strengthen the Rule of Law. A core focus of their work is confronting violence, persecution, and discrimination carried out in the name of religion. In response to the loss of hundreds of innocent lives due to religious extremism, PIL and I-LAP organize peaceful protests, press conferences, and advocacy initiatives to condemn these acts, demand accountability, and highlight the plight of the persecuted Church and other vulnerable communities.



Among the significant incidents where PIL and I-LAP raised their voices and carried out organized advocacy efforts are the Kasur Incident; the Hazara Genocide; the Joseph Colony attacks in Badami Bagh, Lahore; the Burning of Sarhadi Lutheran Church in Mardan; the Kot Radha Kishan incident in District Kasur; the terrorist attack on All Saints Church, Peshawar; the Rimsha Masih case, Islamabad; the Kasur incident and the Gojra incident. Each of these tragedies represents a painful chapter in Pakistan's history, where Christians in particular and other religious minorities suffered immense loss of life, property, dignity, and security.



Through sustained advocacy, PIL and I-LAP-US aim not only to highlight these injustices but also to promote religious freedom, social harmony, and equal citizenship for all Pakistanis, regardless of faith. Their efforts underscore a commitment to standing with the persecuted Church, amplifying the voices of the voiceless, and calling upon state institutions and society at large to uphold constitutional guarantees, protect fundamental human rights, and ensure that such acts of violence and intolerance are neither ignored nor repeated.

I-LAP-US and NBCP are committed to educating, equipping, preparing, and sending local missionaries, evangelists, and faith-based activists to serve among the Unreached People Groups in Pakistan.



Summary of the Gospel unreached!

The Unreached:

The world's population is estimated at 8.23 billion as of July 1, 2025, with 3.42 billion people living in unreached groups that have little or no access to the Gospel. Out of 17,269 global people groups, 7,188—about 42%—remain unreached. These numbers highlight the vastness of the Christian mission and raise an urgent question: has every soul heard the Gospel? This reality intensifies the call for believers to share the Good News so all may have the opportunity to know Christ.



The 10/40 windows:

The 10/40 Window, stretching from Morocco to Japan, is the most critical region for global missions. It contains over 85% of the world's unreached people groups and more than 90% of remaining frontier groups. Home to diverse faiths, including Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Sikhism, and ethnic religions, over 96% of unreached populations live here. For Christians committed to the Great Commission, focusing on the 10/40 Window is essential, offering both a unique opportunity and a profound responsibility to share the Gospel.

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INTERFAITH DIALOGUES: FOSTERING PEACEFUL CO-EXISTENCE

I-LAP-US recognizes interfaith dialogue as a vital tool to promote peaceful coexistence and religious liberty. These dialogues bring together individuals and leaders from diverse religious, ethnic, and cultural backgrounds to foster unity while respecting diversity.

Interfaith Dialogues help bridging divides, dispelling misconceptions, and building mutual understanding. By focusing on shared values, such as compassion, justice, and the sanctity of human life, participants can freely share their beliefs and perspectives without fear of judgment. These conversations reduce prejudice, encourage collaboration, and create pathways for promoting harmony, tolerance, and equality.

In collaboration with I-LAP Pakistan, I-LAP-US organizes dialogues using a structured, inclusive approach. Each dialogue follows a balanced agenda of formal discussions, interactive sessions, and informal activities such as storytelling and sharing of religious practices. Skilled moderators guide discussions with cultural sensitivity, conflict-resolution techniques, and ground rules to maintain respectful and meaningful engagement. The participants include religious leaders, community representatives, scholars, educators, students, activists, and marginalized groups to ensure all voices are heard.

Through these initiatives, I-LAP-US strengthens relationships across communities, nurtures empathy, and builds a foundation for lasting peace, mutual respect, and understanding in Pakistan.

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INTERFAITH HARMONY AND PEACE BUILDING

Pakistan was envisioned by its founder, Mohammad Ali Jinnah, as a nation free from divisions of religion, caste, and creed. However, following his early death in 1948, this vision of a secular and inclusive Pakistan gradually declined and the Majority Muslim population steadily denied their rights to the other faiths. Religious minorities, including Christians, were marginalized, denied quality education, and often relegated to menial jobs.



Today, religious intolerance in Pakistan has reached alarming levels, placing the country among “Countries of Particular Concern” for violations of religious freedom. Much of the blame lies with certain clerics who have sowed prejudiced attitudes among the Muslim majority, discouraging equal treatment, opportunities and respect for religious minorities. As a result, minorities are denied constitutional, civic, and human rights and are often pushed to city outskirts due to poor education and economic exclusion. This sense of superiority fuels discrimination, violence, and attacks on minority communities and their places of worship.



I-LAP-US, in partnership with I-LAP-Pakistan, promotes peace, tolerance, and interfaith harmony by empowering communities, amplifying minority voices, and fostering mutual respect. Through these efforts, they advance social cohesion and contribute to building a more inclusive, harmonious, and peaceful Pakistan.



Key I-LAP Initiatives:

- **Interfaith Christmas Dinners (since 2004):** Bringing people of different faiths together in celebration and fellowship.
- **Interfaith Peace Museum:** Pakistan's first Peace Museum, making it the 34th country globally to establish such a platform.
- **Interfaith Dialogues & Intellectual Hours:** Creating spaces to share ideas, wisdom, and address social and religious challenges collaboratively.
- **Peace Youth Club:** Encouraging students to embrace peace, interfaith harmony, tolerance, and coexistence.
- **Celebration of International Days:** Highlighting tolerance, religious freedom, and interfaith understanding through global commemorations.
